Information for Today's Service

Nursery Care • (0 – 3) available in the main Sanctuary building west hallway (the right hallway).

Sunday School • Families start worship together in our Sanctuary.

- During the service the children are invited up to the front steps for the Children's Blessing. Parents are welcome to join their children.
- After the Children's Blessing, Pre-school through 5th grade students are escorted to their respective classrooms (listed below in bold) by their Sunday School teachers.
- After the service, parents can pick up their children from their classrooms in the McCullen Center (same building as service).
- **Pre-school and Kindergarten** – Sunshine Room located down the sidewalk between Sanctuary building & McCullen Center.
- **1st & 2nd Grades:** Rm 204; **3rd - 5th Grades:** Rm 202 on 2nd floor of McCullen Center.
- **Youth (6th - 12th Grades)** - Youth meet upstairs in the Garage (down the long hallway).

Offering Baskets • Will be passed during the service. Please place your attendance forms, tithes and offerings in the baskets.

Bibles and Church-Wide Printed Announcements • are available in the back of the room. The announcements are free for the taking, but please return the Bible before going home. Please let us know if you would like a Bible to take home!

Coffee and Refreshments • are available before and after the service. You are welcome to bring your coffee into the service. Bring your own travel mug or coffee cup next week to save on supplies and be more spill proof! Enjoy!
