- There is a **Quiet Room** available in the back of the church across from the Nursery for families with infants and small children if needed.
- **Nursery Care** is available for infants through 3 years old in the Nursery located in the west hallway of the church.

Sunday School Classes for Children & Youth

- ◆ Families start worship together in our Sanctuary. During the service the children are invited up to the front steps for the Children's Message. Parents are welcome to join their children.
- ◆ After the Children's Message, Pre-school through 2nd grade students are escorted to their respective classrooms (listed below in bold) by their Sunday School teachers. After the service parents can pick up their children from their classrooms in the McCullen Center building next to the church.
- **Pre-school and Kindergarten children – Sunshine Room** located down the sidewalk to the left as you exit church.
- **1st and 2nd Grade students – Room 204** located on the second floor of the McCullen Center Building (the building next to the church).
- **3rd – 5th grade students – Room 202** located on the second floor of the McCullen Center Building (the building next to the church) or may remain in service with their family for communion.
- **Youth** (6th – 12th grade) - will remain in service with their family for communion.

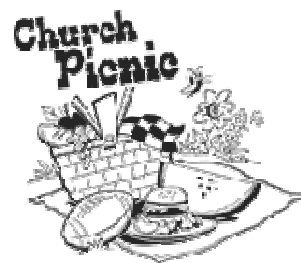

Drop-In Bible Study – 8:45 am Sundays, taught by Ron Reynolds. **New Class August 9, 16 and 23** – The Duty of Pursuing Assurance of Salvation: Presupposed in our Savior's terrifying words during the Sermon on the Mount (Matt. 7:21) was the reality of a glorious throne room of God, the eternal sanctuary of all those who believe in Him, as well as a wretched abyss of torment reserved not just for the powers of darkness but for those who blaspheme against the Triune God, failing to repent in fruit-producing faith. 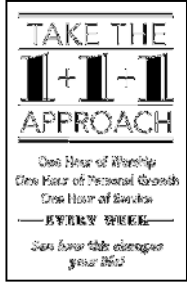
