SANCTUARY

SUNDAY SCHOOL CLASSES FOR CHILDREN & YOUTH

Introduction to Predestination – There are few doctrines in Christianity that are more controversial than the doctrine of predestination, and yet there are few doctrines that can be as great a comfort to a believer. The doctrine of predestination has not only been at the center of much debate, it has also been at the center of much misunderstanding. It has been wrongly defined in terms of fatalism and wrongly defined in terms that rob it of all its biblical weight. Christians must regain a proper understanding of what biblical predestination is and what it is not. The Bible repeatedly speaks of predestination. The question, therefore, is not whether we will have a doctrine of predestination. The question is whether we will have a biblically faithful doctrine of predestination. A proper understanding of this doctrine, rather than being a source of arrogance and pride, should be the source of the greatest joy and humility. May this series better enable you to understand the sovereignty of God in His work of predestination.
