YOUNG ADULT (18-26 years) meets Thursdays 9 pm – 11 pm

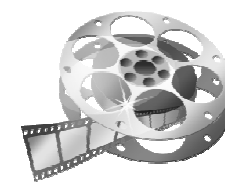

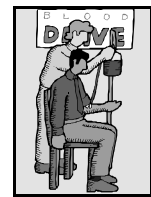
