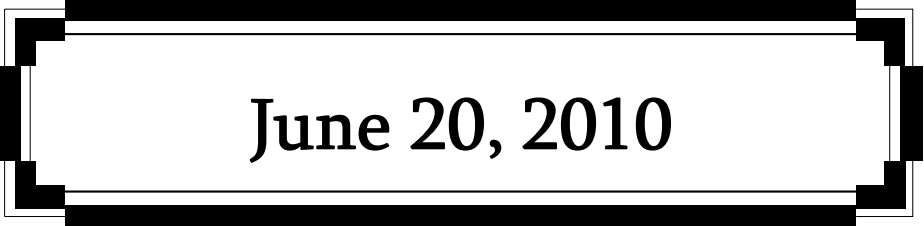

SANCTUARY

- There is a **Quiet Room** available in the back of the church across from the Nursery for families with infants and small children if needed.
- **Nursery Care** is available for infants through 3 years old in the Nursery located in the west hallway of the church.

SUNDAY SCHOOL CLASSES FOR CHILDREN & YOUTH

- ◆ Families start worship together in our Sanctuary. During the service the children are invited up to the front steps for the Children’s Message. Parents are welcome to join their children.
- ◆ After the Children’s Message, all Pre-school through 5th grade students are escorted to their respective classrooms (listed below in bold) by their Sunday School teachers.
- ◆ After the service, parents can pick up their children from their classrooms in the McCullen Center building next to the church.
- **Pre-school and Kindergarten children – Sunshine Room** located down the sidewalk to the left as you exit church.
- **1st and 2nd Grade students – Room 204; 3rd – 5th grades Room 202** located on the second floor of the McCullen Center Building.
- **Youth (6th – 12th grades) - Garage (Youth Room)** Youth meet upstairs in the Garage (Youth Room) for their class.
