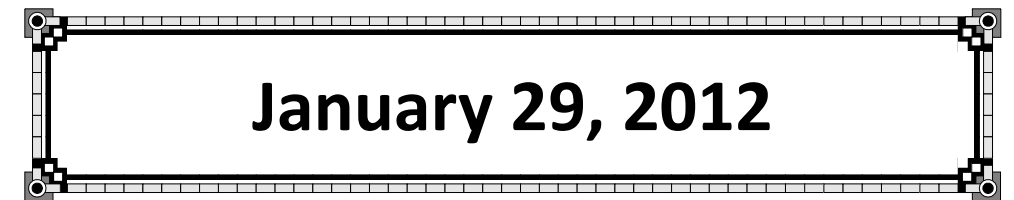

- Families start worship together. During the service the children are invited up to the front for the Children’s Message / Children’s Blessing.
- After the Children’s Message, all Pre-school through 5th grade students are escorted to their respective classrooms (listed below in bold) by their Sunday School teachers.
- After the service, parents can pick up their children from their classrooms in the McCullen Center building next to the Sanctuary.
